

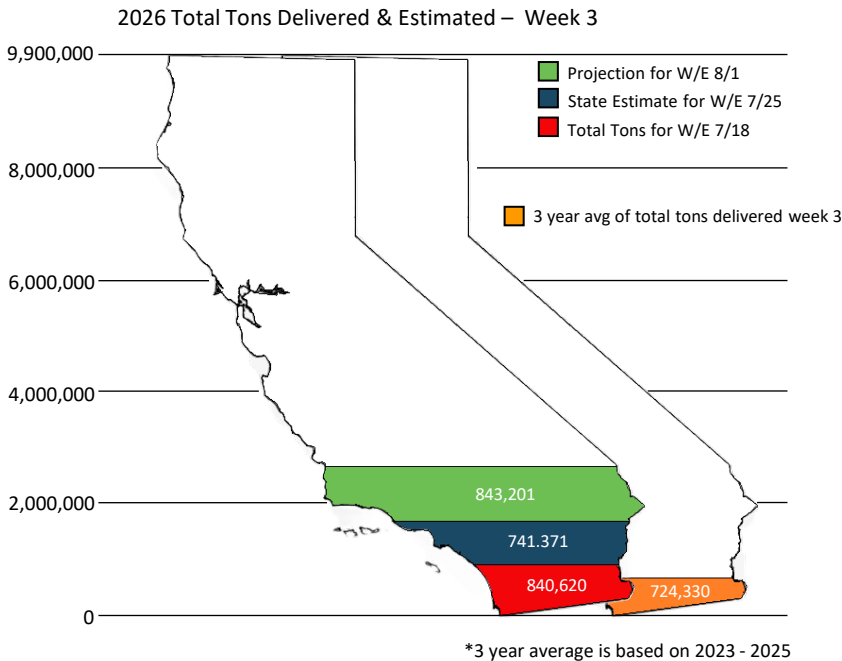
CALIFORNIA TOMATO HARVEST UPDATE

Week Ending July 18, 2026

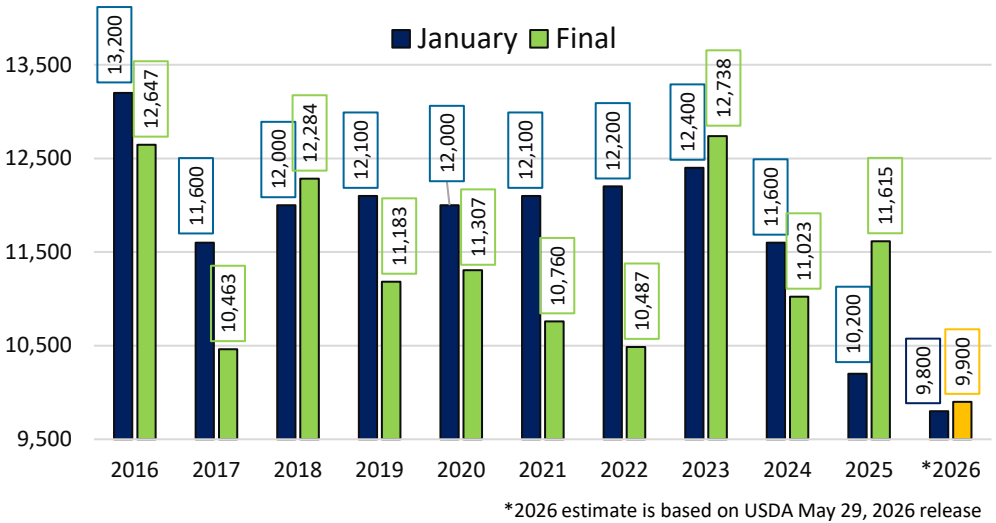
Processing tomato harvest volumes continue to climb.

PTAB reported **840,620 tons** delivered during the third week (ending July 18). Weekly deliveries are projected to total **741,371 tons** for the week ending July 25 and **843,201 tons** for the week ending August 1, bringing the projected year-to-date total to **2,425,192 tons** by August 1.



January USDA Estimate vs Final USDA Estimate

The USDA's May 29 update increased the 2026 production estimate to 9,900 thousand MT. Historical data show that final production estimates often differ from the initial January forecast.



Weather Outlook

Hot weather is expected across California's primary processing tomato regions this week. Prolonged triple-digit heat may accelerate crop maturity and increase plant stress in some areas.
